## Piety And Pity Are Active Expressions Of Mercy

True piety and evangelical pity are found together in those who are moved by the pain of others, take action to help them and, therefore, share God's mercy. "We are called to cultivate attitudes of pity in the face of many situations in life, shaking off the indifference that prevents us from recognizing the needs of our brothers and sisters and liberating ourselves from slavery to material well-being." For Jesus," he said, "experiencing pity means sharing the sadness of those one encounters, but at the same time, working to transform sadness into joy." True piety and true pity are not superficial feelings, he said, but are expressions of compassion and mercy. Pity must not be confused "with the compassion we feel for the animals that live with us," he said. "In fact, it sometimes happens that one feels pity toward animals, but remains indifferent to the suffering of our brothers and sisters.
