



NEW SAINT MICHAEL CEMETERY POLICY

Our cemetery maintenance staff is responsible for the general upkeep of Saint Michael Cemetery. They are not responsible for cleaning up after families who work on or hire someone to work on their family tombs. This has become an unsightly problem especially in the months leading up to All Saints Day.

Every family is responsible for cleaning up after working on a family tomb. Leaving paint chips or any other trash that requires our cemetery staff's attention will now be fined. He fine of \$35 will be assessed to any family who does not pick up after cleaning a family tomb. The fine will be sent via USPS with a photograph of the untidy tomb.

Fines that are not paid will be added to the yearly upkeep bill. Please note that all cemetery upkeep balances must be settled before a tomb can be used again.

ST. MARTIN DE TOURS NOW HIRING BUILDING MAINTENANCE POSITIION

This position requires knowledge and skill in using equipment and tools required to repair and maintain St. Martin de Tours buildings.

This employee's responsibilities will include:

- To assure that the Church and other parish facilities are maintained in a clean and orderly manner at all times.
- To perform general maintenance of parish facilities including but not limited to: keeping gutters and downspouts clean; small paint jobs; keeping areas around A/C units free of debris; preventative maintenance; minor electrical, plumbing; and carpentry jobs; mopping; sealing, vacuuming of floors; emptying of waste containers and cleaning of restrooms.
- To keep storage/shop area clean and organized.
- To dust mop the Church and empty all waste containers in Church on Friday and as needed. To wet mop the church every other month or as needed.
- To set up tables and chairs in parish facilities for various functions, as designed by the Pastor.
- To assist with moving liturgical decorations to and from the church and warehouse, as needed.
- To keep the parish restrooms clean throughout the day.
- To empty trash cans in public areas and restrooms of the Church office, Parish Hall, School buildings and the Church buildings.
- To perform monthly, semi annual and annual janitorial duties and projects as scheduled in consultation with the Pastor.
- To safely store and secure all cleaning supplies and equipment.
- To maintain all equipment, keeping it in safe working order.
- Other duties as directed by the Pastor.
- To clean and maintain the Marian Fountain.
- Check all areas of facility, parking lots and grounds.
- Engage in special preventive maintenance, repair or cleaning of all facilities as time allows.

The employee is required to stand, stoop, bend, walk, sit, talk, hear, grasp, reach, and perform repetitive motions of the fingers, hands, wrists, and feet.

- Must be able to push, pull, lift, and carry items up to 50 pounds.
- Work is primarily performed indoors; however some outdoor work may by necessary.
- Position may require exposure to chemical, dust, dirt, and bacteria.
- May be required to work beyond regular work hours, as directed by the Pastor.
